Type 14039 in Find box and Click find

It is recommended the victim check the first two boxes on form 14039, checking the second box will place an alert on their account for three (3) years

Form **14039** must be mailed with their **tax forms**, a copy of a form of **identification** such as a social security card, passport, or state id, and a copy of the **Sheriff's Office report**. The above information should be mailed to the following address:

The victim should contact the **Social Security Administration** to report the fraudulent use of their social security number.

Additionally, the victim should contact the **Federal Trade Commission** to file a complaint by telephone or website: <u>www.ftc.gov</u>. They should also contact one of the credit bureaus to run a credit report and place a fraud alert on their account. **Equifax 1-800-685-1111, Experian 1-888-397-3742, or Transunion 1-800-888-4213** or by website <u>www.annualcreditreport.com</u>.
